- Always attend class.
 - Be on time. Listen. Take notes. Actively participate.
- Talk to your TA and/or Professor. Visit during office hours.
 - Always review material and come prepared with questions.

- Review your notes daily to help you retain the information. Study smarter.
- Ask questions early, when they first arise. It will help you stay on top of the material.
