YOUR BUSINESS CLASSES

- Always attend class.
 - Be on time. Listen. Take notes. Actively participate.
- Talk to your TA and/or Professor. Visit during office hours.
 - Always review material and come prepared with questions.
 - Get to know your Professors.
- Review your notes daily to help you retain the information. Study smarter.
- Ask questions early, when they first arise. It will help you stay on top of the material.
- Stay current. Pay attention to business news and current topics. You will start to see what you are learning in class apply in current business examples.
- Avoid memorization. You have to be able to apply the information to succeed. If you can explain it, you understand it.
- Work through the problems and homework to develop understanding.
