YOUR MATH CLASSES

YOUR MATH CLASSES

- Always attend class.
 - Be on time. Listen. Take notes. Actively participate.
- Talk to your TA and/or Professor. Visit during office hours.
 - Always review material and come prepared with questions.
 - Get to know your Professors.
- Work on problems after each class. Math builds on the previous knowledge. If you understand material from the previous class, the new information will make more sense.
 - Work the example problems shown from class on your own. Make sure you understand how to do them before working on the homework.
- Practice by doing many exercises. Do all of the assigned homework problems and try some extras to prepare for quizzes and exams.
- Utilize the campus labs and resources! Plan in advance, make an appointment or drop in during drop in hours.
