Tips for Success for...

ALL OF YOUR CLASSES

- Always attend class.
 - Be on time. Listen. Take notes. Actively participate.
- Talk to your TA and/or Professor. Visit during office hours.
 - Always review material and come prepared with questions.
 - Get to know your Professors.
- Eat breakfast every morning. It will help you with concentration and retention of information in class.
- Ask questions early, when they first arise. It will help you stay on top of the material.
- During class and while you are studying, put your phone on silent and put it away. The less distractions you have the more focused you will be.
- Read the textbook before class. Rewrite your notes from class at the end of each day and organize them. You may not remember what your notes meant a few days later, review after class to retain the information.
